


- TOUHOKU Highway to HANYU Interchange (25minutes).

Get a close-up perspective of Gyoda's wildlife.


Life-like replicas enable you to learn about many of the insects, birds, small animals and the aquatic life in this area.

OBSERVATION TOWER




Panoramic view from 50 metres above the Ancient Lotus Park!

GYODAHASU



When the people of Gyoda built the sanitation site, they came across ancient lotus seeds imbedded in the soil. The pink flowers are thought to be 1400 to 3000 years old. The flowers became a natural monument that can now be seen, along with forty other lotus species, from mid-June to mid-August.
